Former Fort Bend County Tax Assessor-Collector Patsy Schultz Passes Away

SCHULENBERG, TX — Former Fort Bend County Tax Assessor-Collector Patsy Schultz passed away today, January 17th, 2022. She was 73.

Schultz, a 30-year veteran of the Fort Bend County Tax Assessor-Collector’s Office, was elected Tax Assessor-Collector in 2004 and served in that position until her retirement in 2019.

Schultz lived in Schulenberg, Texas with her life partner, Bobby Weddle. In addition to Weddle, Schultz is survived by two daughters, Monica Canady and her husband, Jerry; and Stephanie Norwood and her husband, Michael; and two grandchildren, Luke Canady and Lauren Canady.
